Whereupon he together with Jeremiah Darden & Edwin Daugherty, Godwin Parker, & James Vaughan his securities (who were sworn in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into (and acknowledged aloud in the presence of six thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law.

The Court doth assign John B. Haggins guardian of Richard Parker a son of Richard Parker dec'd. Whereupon he together with Jos. C. Veltelle & Joshua Dutton his securities (who were sworn in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into (and acknowledged aloud in the presence of one thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law.

Ordered that the License granted to Nathl. R. Blaw to keep an ordinary at his house at Jerusalem until the next April Term of his Court be transferred to Solomon Woodson. Whereupon he entered bond & security according to Law & in open Court took the oath required by Law.
