Whereupon the said Jesse Beale together with Dennis Bryant & Jasper Beale his securities, acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the manner following, that is to say, the said Jesse Beale himself in the sum of fifty dollars, and the said Dennis Bryant & Jesse Beale his securities, in the like sum of fifty dollars to be levies of their goods and chattels lands and tenements and the use of the said Commonwealth's revenues. Yet upon this condition that if the said Jesse Beale shall personally appear before the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County, on the first day of the next term to stand his trial for a felony by him committed in this County within the jurisdiction of this Court within that that the said Jesse Beale did on the 24th day of January in the year 1859 unlawfully and maliciously shoot with a gun loaded with powder and shot and leaden balls in the County of Southampton and did thereby wound one Nancy Beale with intent to maim disfigure & disable and kill the said Nancy Beale and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue -
