

The Court taking into consideration the report of the Commissioners appointed to examine & report to Court a plan of building a new Clerk's office & repairing the old one in this County do hereby set the ^{2nd} plan reported by them for building a new Clerk's office and appoint Seth H. Bishop H. M. Banta and John Kell Commissioners to have the same built according to the said ^{2nd} Plan by the lowest bidder.

About all the Justices except James C. Ellis, Presiding Justice, Day: P. Kinsler, Elliott L. Lutz, Angus Lutz and Elijah Jagers, Justices,

Ordered that Wmth Summell & James C. Jones, two of the Commissioners of roads of this County do to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Upper Newark Bridge and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that Wmth L. Briggs, Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Richard H. Beach dec^d. & administer the same according to Law.

Ordered that Wmth L. Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Rebecca Smart wife of A. L. Jones & administer the same according to Law.

Ordered that the Clerk register Moses Hill, free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of James Giffen Jr.

On the application of James N. Bell who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by Law, a License is granted him to keep an ordinary at his house in this County until the next April Term of this Court. It being the opinion of the Court that he is sober and of good character and will probably keep a house orderly, useful and such as the Law requires - And thereupon in open Court entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars with sufficient security conditioned according to Law, & took the oath prescribed by Law.

James Wallace & James Relye, white persons who stand charged with a felony by them committed in this County, and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that they the said Wallace & Relye did on the 21st day of December A.D. 1858 maliciously and unlawfully stab, cut and wound Albert Hobbs with intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill him the said Hobbs were this day again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County. And on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for reasons appearing to the Court, the examination is continued until the next term of this Court, and they are remanded to jail.

Robert Cunniff, Robt Whithead, George Turner, Ben Johnson, &c. Tracked Vick who were summoned to appear here in this day as witnesses on behalf of the Commonwealth against James Wallace and James Relye were solemnly called but came not; therefore on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth it is ordered that they be summoned to appear here in the first day of the next term of this Court to their own, if any they can, why an attachment should not be issued against them.
