

The Court taking into consideration the report of the Commissioners appointed to examine & report to Court a plan of building a new Clerk's office or repairing the old one in this County doth adopt the 2nd plan reported by them for building a new Clerk's office, and appoint Eliz. A. Bishop H. M. Butts and John Bell Commissioners to have the same built according to the said Plan by the lowest bid.

Direct all the Justices except James C. Sims, Presiding Justice, R. S. Kinsler, Elliott L. Say, Shugars Lamb and Elijah Taylor, Justices,

Ordered that Wm. H. Summerville & James C. Jones, two of the Commissioners of roads of this County let to the Court and undertake the repair of Upper Beaver Bridge and receive the same when completed you make report to Court.

Ordered that Wm. H. Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Richard H. Brock deceased & minister the same according to Law.

* Ordered that Wm. H. Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hand the estate of Rebecca Farmer wife of A. L. Turner & minister the same according to Law.

* Ordered that the Clerk register Moses Hill, free negro, who was born free in this County as a slave by the testimony of James Gafford Jr.

On the application of James N. Bell who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the Tax imposed by Law, a License is granted him to keep an Ordinary at his house in this County until the next April Term of this Court. It being the opinion of the Court that he is sober and of good character and will probably keep a house orderly, useful and such as the law requires. And therupon in open Court entered into and acknowledged before me the sum of Five hundred dollars with sufficient security conditioned according to Law, & took the oath prescribed by Law.

James Wallace & James Rely the white persons who stand charged with affray by them committed in this County, and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that they the said Wallace & Rely the 8th day of December A.D. 1858 maliciously and unlawfully stab, cut and wound Elbert Hobbs with intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill him the said Hobbs won this day again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for reasons appearing to the Court, this examination is continued until the next term of this Court, and they are remanded to jail.
