

Conveying Land, was admitted to record, February 23rd 1859.

Deed of Trust dated 18th January 1859, between Thomas Elkins of the first part, John Backland of the second part and George G. Rose of the third part, Conveying personal property was admitted to record, February 28th 1859.

Deed of Deed of Sale dated 5th February 1859 from Sally Joyce to Milton D. Battell - Conveying A. Land, was admitted to record, March 3rd 1859.

Deed of Trust dated 5th March 1859, from Edwin Readshaw to Franklin V. L. Conveying real and personal property to came Milton D. Battell, was admitted to record, March 9th 1859.

Deed of Trust dated 8th March 1859, from Joseph P. Elkins to Joseph Gardner conveying personal property to come Wathin W. Stephenson, was admitted to record, March 14th 1859.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next term of this Court to take into consideration the propriety of allowing the merchants in this County to sell by retail Ancient Spirits or a mixture thereof at their respective stores.

On the motion of James C. Schell executor of William J. Bell Jr. It is advised that the Account of his Transactions as reported after said and returned to this Court be recommitted to a Committee of this Court for a resettlement after same.

An Inquisition taken at an old Well near Battell's Meeting House on the 25th day of Feb 1859, before Shadrach Lantz a Justice of the peace of said County upon the body of a white child unknown where lying dead - was this day returned and ordered to be filed.

The last Will and Testament of Wm T. Battell dec'd was proved by the oaths of Benjamin J. Ranch and Geo. H. Darden, the Subscribing witnesses thereto and was admitted to be recorded. And on the motion of James J. Darden, the executor therein named who made oath and together with Richard J. Darden and Davis Bennett his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand Dollars, conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that Parker D. Tracy, Mayes Tracy, Benjamin Buffum and Goodwyn D. Battell or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels personal estate of Wm T. Battell dec'd. that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Isaac Cox who made oath and together with Joshua Pittman & Benjamin Drennan his securities (who justify on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged above mentioned bond in the penalty of fifty dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Franklin Robinson dec'd in due form.

Wathin W. Stephenson is appointed Surveyor of the road from Dickville to Gray's Old Place in the room of P. H. Hollings dec'd and it is advised that the annual sum to be paid thereon.
