This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant in his proper person and as witnesses the plaintiff's action for \$1840, . will instruct them from the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1857, the debt and interest in the writing mentioned. Wherefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the sum of eighteen hundred and forty dollars with legal interest thereon from the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1857, till paid and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended. And the said defendant in money ye.

James Wallace, a white person who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that the said James Wallace did on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1858, in the County of Southampton maliciously and unlawfully stab, cut and wound Elbert Hobbs with intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill the said Hobbs was this day again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and the Court having heard the evidence and of opinion that a felony has been committed in that there is probable cause to charge the accused therewith and doth remand him for trial in the Circuit Court of this County. On the motion of James Wallace the Court being of opinion that he is entitled to bail, doth order that the said James Wallace be allowed to enter into recognizance in the penalty of \$500.00 with sufficient surety in the like sum of \$500.00 for his appearance before the said Circuit Court on the first day after next term of the said Court to stand his trial for the offence aforesaid with which he stands charged. And the said James Wallace is remanded to jail.

It is remembered that Robert Comely, Wm. Bishop, John H. Stith, Geo. F. Camp, Godwin Jones, Elbert Hobbs, C.C. Burton & Peter Vick came into Court and acknowledged themselves to be severally indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of \$300.00 each of their respective goods and chattels hands and tenements to be made and levied and for the use of the said Commonwealth rendered; Yet upon this condition that if they and each of them shall make their personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of the next term give evidence on behalf of the Commonwealth against James Wallace, a white person who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that the said James Wallace did on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1858, in the County of Southampton maliciously and unlawfully stab, cut and wound Elbert Hobbs with intent to maim, disfigure and kill the said Hobbs and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance to be void, or else to remain in full or virtue.
