

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant in his proper person and acknowledges the plaintiff's action for \$1840 is with interest thereon from the 26th March 1857, that debt and interest in the withinmentioned. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the sum of eighteen hundred and forty dollars with legal interest thereon from the 26th day of March 1857, till paid and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended. And the said defendant in money.

Present, James Dillard, Justice

James Wallace, a white person who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that the said James Wallace did on the 30th day of December A.D. 1858, in the County of Southampton maliciously and unlawfully stab, cut and wound Albert Hobbs with intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill the said Hobbs was this day again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and the Court having heard the evidence and of opinion that a felony has been committed and that there is probable cause to charge the accused thereunto and doth remand him for trial in the Circuit Court of this County. On the motion of James Wallace the Court being of opinion that he is entitled to bail, doth order that the said James Wallace be allowed to enter into recognizance in the penalty of \$500.00 with sufficient surety in the like sum of \$500.00 for his appearance before the said Circuit Court on the first day of the next term of the said Court to stand his trial for the offence aforesaid with which he stands charged. And the said James Wallace is remanded to jail.

It is remembered that Robert Connolly, Wm Bishop, John H. Steth, Geo S. Camp, Gordon Emco, Albert Hobbs, W.C. Bunker and John Vick came into Court and acknowledged themselves to be severally indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of \$200.00 each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be made and levied and for the use of the said Commonwealth rendered; Yet upon this condition that if they and each of them shall make their personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of the next term of the said Court in behalf of the Commonwealth against James Wallace, a white person who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that the said James Wallace did on the 30th day of December A.D. 1858, in the County of Southampton maliciously and unlawfully stab, cut and wound Albert Hobbs with intent to maim, disfigure and kill the said Hobbs and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance to be void, or else to remain in full and virtue.
