Vick, his securities, (who testified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged alone in the presence of sixteen hundred dollars conditions according to Law.

Ordered that the sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next term of this Court to take into consideration the propriety of allowing Joshua Crumpler to sell by retail ardent spirits or a mixture thereof at his store.
