Therefore it is ordered that the said Jeremiah Hedgcock be charged with the payment annually the sum of twenty dollars agree to the overseers of the poor of the said County for the space of eight years from the birth of the said child least: the 6th day of March 1857 in case the said child lives so long. And that he enter into bond in the penalty of three hundred and twenty dollars with sufficient security conditioned to perform the above order of Court which is accordingly done.

Ordered that Saml. Drury & Thomas M. Merson two of the Commissioners of the County let to the lowest undertaker the upper bridge over Lewis C. Merson's Mill Swamp & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that Saml. Drury & Thomas M. Merson two of the Commissioners of the roads of the County let to the lowest undertaker with Commissioners of Greenville County the rebuilding of Haley's bridge & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Mills Pope is appointed Surveyor of the road from sign post near George C. Pope's to Bannet's road near Thomas Knight's and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that James D. Bryant and Warren Edwards two of the Commissioners of roads of the County with Commissioners to be appointed by the County Court of Isle of Wight County let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge near Franklin over Blackwater river. and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that the Clerk register Rebecca Jane Levi free negro who was born free in this County as appears by her former register and Peggy Levi who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of her former register.

Abraham C. Bray is appointed Surveyor of the road from Cedar Swamp to Franklin in room of Richard Barrett exmoed. And it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.
