May 28<sup>th</sup> 1859.

Alexander W. Newell, Conveying Land, was admitted to record, June 13<sup>th</sup> 1859.

The Commissioner appointed to bid to the lowest and take the repairs of Dry

Ordered that the Clerk register Henry Holland, fitter, who was last free in this County  
as appears by the testimony of Goodman C. Johnson.

On the Application of Elijah Jones who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the Tax  
imposed by law, a License is granted him to keep an ordinary at his respective  
house in this County until the next April term of this Court. It being the opinion  
of the Court that he is sober and of good character and will probably keep
