Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James M. Ramsey dec'd. in due form.

The Court with the consent of John W. Gardner, agree to pay him hereafter one hundred dollars per annum for the free passage of the citizens of this County over Cherry Cross ferry.

The Court doth set aside the order heretofore made appointing Commissioners to have a new Clerk's office built and appointed Henry M. Bault, John Cobb and L. R. Edwards, Commissioners to have ^{the same repaired} ~~new~~ porch or porches built in front of the present Clerk's office, purposes placed in the upper part of the office. In books of papers if receive the same when completed I make report to Court.
