

Barges pay to the plaintiff \$12.55 with interest from 1<sup>st</sup> March 1856, all paid

The Court doth certify that from satisfactory evidence adduced to it Samuel

signed by them shall be reported to Court and it is ordered that the Sheriff  
summon all the acting Justices of the peace of this County to the next  
term to ratify the said Contract

of roads of this County let to the lowest bidder the rebuilding of the
