

Barges pay to the plaintiff \$12.55 with interest from 1st March 1851, till paid
\$18.72 etc costs & his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended, or such
an amount as he may have in his hands belonging to the Defendant.

The Court doth certify that from satisfactory evidence adduced to it Samuel
Olney minor child of Natham Olney dec'd. to whom County Land warrant No 73,
662 dated 9th September 1857 for 120 acres of Land issued, arrived to the age
of twenty one years sometime in March 1857 and that Francis Olney widow of
the said Natham Olney died 7th May 1856, at which ^{time} the said Samuel
Olney was twenty years one month & 17 Days of age.

signed by them shall be reported to Court and it is ordered that the Sheriff
summon all the acting Justices of the peace of this County to the next
term to ratify the said Contract
