The Commissioners appointed to have the said road altered and put in good order by the said Appelwhite, this day report that the same has been altered and put in good order by the said Appelwhite which report is received and the said road as altered is adopted as a public highway of this County and the old road is discontinued and it is ordered that the hands that usually worked at the old road do work on the road as altered

The Court doth adjoint Merv^t. J. Davis as guardian of his infant daughter Marcella T. Davis. W^thout payment to him together with Madison J. Davis, his son, (who justified on such as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledge a bond in the penalty of Two hundred Dollars conditioned according to Law.
