Rugg the executors thereunto, who recd. each and tendered with Nathan D. Goffe, George C. Goffe, Wm. C. Jayne & Francis T. Kelly, George A. Musgrave and Wm. F. Francis their deponents, who justified each as to their sufficiency, intelligence and acknowledged above in the penalty of One hundred and fifty thousand dollars conditions according to Law, Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that James R. Jayne, John Whithead, Nathan A. Thomas, John A. Person and Edward S. Turner, or any three of them, being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Peter Edwards deceased that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

The Commissioners appointed to reduce to writing a contract between the Counties of Southampton and New Castle and Wm. D. Bryant and Parker D. Revelly to take account from them for the rebuilding of Hale's bridge, this day returned the contract and bill signed by the said Wm. D. Bryant, Parker Revelly & Wm. J. Bryant and the Court (the Justices having been summoned for the purpose) taking the same into consideration doth approve and ratify the said Contract and bill on behalf of this County.

The Court doth record the order of this Court made at the January term of the Court to let out the repairs of the Clerks office of this County and directed that John Cobb and Henry M. Bush, two of the Commissioners of roads of this County be caused to be lawfully undertaken the enlargement of the office by the addition of a piece the size of the present porch as further to have the same repaired where necessary and new locks case placed in the upper part of the same and receive the sum when completed of which report to Court.
