Williams.

The Commissioners appointed to bid to the Court undertake the repairs of the Farmer's bridges this day made their report, which is ordered to be filed.

The last Will and Testament of James Clayton dec. was proved by the oaths of Alfred S. Stephenson and Robert M. Dolanoff the subscribing witnesses thereto and thereupon ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of A. S. M. Pranges, James M. M. Clancy, Richard W. Clayton and Mordred M. Clayton, the executors therein named who made oath (and together with Wm. D. M. Clancy, ~~Robert M. Dolanoff~~, Allen Edwards, Alfred S. Stephenson & Thomas J. Davis, his securities, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Eight thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, the Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.
