

At a Monthly Term of the County Court of Southampton County, held at the Court House, thereof, on Monday, the 17th day of October 1859.
Present, James E. Peters, presiding Justice, John B. Briggs, Robert M. Dolan, & Shugart Linn, Justices.

The Clerk this day returned a List of all Writings admitted to record in this Court during and since the last preceding Term under Chapter 121 of the Code of Virginia, which List having been read to the Court is ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day and is as follows, to-wit:

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 11th May 1859, from John R. Chumbley, Richard H. Drake Jr. and E. W. Massenburg, Commissioners to Peter Edwards. Conveying Land, was admitted to record, 19th September 1859.

Deed of Trust dated 15th September 1859, between Richard Johnson, of the first part, Abram Kiddick, of the second part, and J. J. Daugherty, of the third part, conveying personal property, was admitted to record 19th September 1859.

Deed of Trust dated 16th September 1859, from Joseph Joyner (of the first part) to Henry F. Vick conveying personal estate to secure Richard J. Darden & Jas. D. Poyant. was admitted to record, 21st September 1859.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 26th February 1859 from Henry Jones wife to Charlotte Leigh conveying Land was admitted to record 23rd September 1859.

Deed of Trust dated 28th September 1859, from Richard H. Guadalupe to Robert B. Pittow, conveying personal property, to secure Robert Pittow & R. E. Meade was admitted to record, October 1st 1859.

Ordered that Demarius L. Dolan & James G. Jones two of the Commissioners of roads of this County let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Black Creek bridge near William Atkinson's & receive the same when completed make report to Court.

Ordered that James D. Poyant & Melan Edwards two of the Commissioners of roads of this County let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge over Nolhoway river at Jerusalem yet Buttrick's of same & the other Bridges on the embankments leading from said Bridge, & receive the same when completed and make report to Court.

The last Will and Testament of Lucy Parker dec'd was partly proved by the oath of James E. Peters, one of the subscribing witnesses thereto (and the same is continued for further proof.

The last Will and testament of Rebecca Thurston dec'd was partly proved by the oath of Melan Edwards, one of the subscribing witnesses thereto and the same is ordered to be continued for further proof.

On the motion of Leonard C. Cobb guardian of Richd. L. Daughan he is allowed to expend the sum of fifty Dollars of the principal of his said ward's estate for his Education.
