into an acknowledgement aband in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned ac-  
cording to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration  
on the estate of the said Catherine Adams dec'd. with her will annexed inde-  
pendent.

Ordered that Wm. A. Jones, Julius C. Harris and S. McWilliams, be  
sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods or chattels of Catherine  
Adams dec'd. that may be produced to them to make due return of the  
same.

Marchal Williams widow of Seth D. Williams dec'd. having relinquished to  
qualify as his administrator in favor of Edward Rawls. On the motion of  
the said Edward Rawls who made oath and together with Josiah P. Gay  
& Elizab. Rawls, his daughter, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency)  
entered into an acknowledgement aband in the penalty of six thousand dollars  
conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters  
of administration on the estate of the said Seth D. Williams dec'd. in  
due form.

Ordered that Wm. C. Gay, John R. Higgins, W. W. Lawrence & Goodman  
& Johnson, or any three of them, being sworn for the purpose, do appraise  
all the goods or chattels of Seth D. Williams dec'd. that may be pro-  
duced to them to make due return of the same.
