Hollings having severally been one month and upwards in the Clerk's office and there being no exceptions there were severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The Account of R. H. Dutton's administration on the estate of Thomas R. Dutton dec'd. The account of the Debts & Demands against the said Thomas R. Dutton his sureties conditioned that John J. Hinckley do and shall keep the peace towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth and especially towards Francis W. Parker for the space of one year from the date then of and ordered to be filed.

On the motion of Wm. W. Briggs doth order that John D. Parker's guardian of Samuel and Mary W. Parker be allowed to expend the sum of thirty five dollars out of the principal of his wards estate for their support and maintenance 1860.
