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making considered, it seems to the Court that there is error in the judgment aforesaid. Therefore it is ordered that the judgment of the Justice be reversed and annulled and that the appeal be remanded against the appellant his costs in this behalf expended as well as he could be for the Justice.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in his hands and not otherwise expended pay to Dr. C. R. L. Commercial \$352.83 for this County's proportion for the repairs of Dunstable bridge.

On the motion of C. F. Negus guardian of M. W. & F. M. Negus he is exempt in future from the payment of all County taxes on Sarah Bull, Mary and Catherine three old Negroes.

The Court being satisfied that Wm. R. Shands was erroneously charged with a tax for the year 1859 in \$1550.00 income tax of Office amounting to \$31.00 and that he has paid the same, on the application of said Wm. R. Shands order that the said amount of taxes paid by said Wm. R. Shands be refunded to him, the Attorney for the Commonwealth being present in Court defending the application.
