

Deed of Bargain & Sale Dated 26th June 1860, from C. Henry J. Hens and Charles to John H. Bishop. Conveying Land was admitted to record June 26th 1860.

Deed of Bargain & Sale Dated 2nd Decr 1859 from Oliver Branch to Duke Morgan. Conveying Land was admitted to record, February 7th 1860.

Deed of Land, dated 16th February 1860, from Augustus Bondy to William Henry Lee & Quinton & Bony. Conveying Land. was admitted to record, February 17th 1860.

On the motion of William C. Gay guardian of J. S. C., Calvert Co., Prince George's County, Md. & Robert J. Parker of Richard Parker dec'd, he is allowed to expend the sum of \$50.00 each of the principal of his ward's estate for their support &c.

The last will and testament of Abeline R. Briggs was proved by the oaths of Wm. L. Cobb & J. M. Butts the subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded. On the motion of Henry M. Butts (his executor being named in the will) as he made oath (and together with Wm. L. Cobb his security) (to the justice and equity as to his executing) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned according to law, the Clerk is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration with the will annexed in the estate of the said Abeline R. Briggs dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that John Webb, Jas. T. Butts and Henry Gay being sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods & chattels of Abeline R. Briggs dec'd. that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

Ordered that the Clerk register Morning Scott, free agent, who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Robert L. Dillards Comd' as Briggs & he was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of John Campbell.

On the motion of John Washam the License granted to Robert L. Anderson to keep and manage a house of gaming with the view & spirit of this Court is transferred to the said Washam. It being the opinion of the Court that he is sober & of good character & will faithfully keep a house ready & lawful & such as the law requires. Whereupon he is ordered to enter into bond in the penalty of one hundred Dollars conditioned according to law with sufficient security, & to take the oath prescribed by law.

On motion of Lucy J. Randall & children, Robert E. Randall is appointed Executor in the Estate of Isaac J. Randall dec'd. which died bearing date the 1st day of 1844 from James E. Allen & of record in the Clerk's office of Washington County Court.

On the motion of Ann Evers it is ordered that the Indenture binding Martha Ann Evers daughter of E. J. Annis to Wm. M. Evers be transferred with said Ann Evers, & that she be released from the payment of the fine & dollars for account required to be paid in said Indenture.
