

To the next term of this Court to take into consideration the propriety of allowing the merchants in this County to sell by retail wine, brandy spirits or a mixture thereof at their respective stores and to prepare a list of such inhabitants of the County not exempted, as they shall think well qualified to serve as jurors, being persons of sound judgment and free from legal exception.

On the motion of James Holmes guardian of Wm H. Vick he is authorized to sell either a slave the property of the said Wm H. Vick, as shall seem to him best (and make report there of to Court.

On the motion of Timothy D. Bachman and his children - John H. Lefors is appointed trustee in the place of John W. Rice deceased in and of trust dated 22^d June 1833 (and read in the Clerk's office of Southampton County Court the 25th June 1833, executed by the said Timothy D. Bachman to John L. Gray trustee upon his executing bond with sufficient security in the penalty of Six thousand conditioned for the faithful discharge of his duties as trustee aforesaid. Whereupon the said John H. Lefors together with D. H. Thorpe and John S. Sumner, his securities, by L. R. Edwards their attorney in fact acting under a power of attorney under their hands & seals entered into and acknowledged bonds in the penalty of Six thousand Dollars conditioned for the faithful discharge of his duties as trustee aforesaid.

Ordered that the Clerk register Samsy Holloman Freeman, who was born in this County as appears by the testimony of Ro. M. Doler.

Daniels were sworn a Grand jury of inquest for the body of this County, and having received their charge withdrew (and after some time returned into Court and presented (here indict them) And then the said Grand Jury having nothing further to present were discharged.

Ordered that James G. Jones & Edmund L. Doler, two of the Commissioners of roads of this County examine & let to the lowest bidder the repairs or rebuilding of the Bridge across Round Hill Swamp near Edmund Lefors's and receive the same when completed and make report to Court.
