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These causes came on this day to be again heard on the papers formerly read and on the reports of the Commissioners made at the last term of this Court to which report there is no exception and was argued by Counsel on consideration whereof the Court approving and confirming the reports doth adjudge order and decree that the same be held firm and stable and binding between the parties forever and that the costs of these causes be proportionally borne by the parties.

The amount of Wm R. Shew's administration on the estate of A. M. Howell dec'd and the amount of the debts and demands against the said A. M. Howell dec'd or his estate, of Mary V. Donaghy's administration on the estate of Francis P. Wells dec'd of Wm W. Briggs Sheriff's administration on the estate of H. D. Moore dec'd of James D. Bingham's Executorial proceedings on the estate of Nathan B. Bingham dec'd and the amount of the debts and demands against the said Nathan B. Bingham dec'd or his estate, of Delila Vick's administration on the estate of James Vick dec'd of Andrew J. Vick's administration on the estate of James Vick dec'd having severally laid in month and upwards in the Clerk's office and there being no exceptions thereto were severally affirmed, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the Clerk register Catharine L. Stanton, free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of John B. Raykin.
