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This day came the parties by their attorneys, and it appearing to the Court that the appeal aforesaid, was not allowed in the time prescribed by law it is ordered that the same be dismissed. On the motion of Alfred T. Stephenson to alter the road from Allen Edwards to Jesse Johnson's. The Court taking into consideration the report of the Commissioners doth adopt the same and direct that James G. Jones & Demarius L. Dole two of the Commissioners aforesaid of this County have the same altered as proposed provided the same shall be opened without any cost upon the County and receive the same when completed and make report to Court.
