

Upon satisfactory testimony produced before the Court, the Court doth certify that William Owens indebted to said Alaman No 1150 1/2 containing 120 acres which expired on the 16th day of January 1856 departed this life on the 26th day of June in the year 1855 testate leaving no widow nor child or other descendant, but leaving as his heirs and only heirs at law, Martha Cobb and Samuel Williams and the Court doth further certify that the last will and testament of William Owens deceased was duly admitted to probate in this Court at its July term 1855 and that Letters Testamentary were granted unto Jeremiah O. Johnson who was constituted Executor in the last will and testament of William Owens deceased, which facts will more fully appear by reference to a certified copy of the will annexed to his certificate.

On the motion of Robert Parks who is bound in this Court as the surety of Richard Barrett as guardian of Erastus Barrett his infant son. It is ordered that the said Richard Barrett appear instantaneously before this Court and enter into a new bond as guardian of the said Erastus Barrett in the penalty of \$20000 with good security conditions according to law or have his powers as guardian of the said Erastus Barrett annulled. The said Richard Barrett having appeared in Court and acknowledged service of this motion. Whereupon the said Richard Barrett as guardian of the said Erastus Barrett together with Wilbur W. Lawrence and Jas. J. Darden his sureties, (who justified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond with penalty of twenty thousand dollars conditioned according to law

Ordered that the account of Dr. Wm. R. Jackson for attendance on John Fairclough charged with felony amounting to \$10.00 be certified to the auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment.
