 further certify that the last Will and testament of William Owens
 deceased was duly admitted to probate in this Court on its July term
 1855 and that Letters Testamentary were granted unto Jeremiah O. Johnson
 who was constituted Executor in the last will and testament of William
 Owens deceased, which fact will more fully appear by reference to
 an certified copy of the will annexed to this certificate.

In the mean time of Robert Banks who is bound in this Court as the Surety
 of Richard Barrett as guardian of Erastus Barrett his infant son, It
 is ordered that the said Richard Barrett appear instantaneously before this Court
 and enter into a new bond as guardian of the said Erastus Barrett in
 the penalty of \$30000 - with good security conditioned according
 to law or have his powers as guardian affixed thereto
 and that the said Richard Barrett pay the costs of this judgment
 and amuledly the said Richard Barrett having appeared in Court and
 acknowledged service of this judgment. Whereupon the said Richard
 Barrett as guardian of the said Erastus Barrett together with Willis
 W. Lawrence and Jas J. Dardent his securities, who justified on oath
 as to their sufficiency entered into and acknowledged above abond with
 a penalty of twenty thousand Dollars conditioned according to law

Ordered that the amount of Dr Wm R Parker for attendance on
 John Fairchild charged with filing amounted to \$10.00 be certified
 to the auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment.
