On the motion of a Nathan McNeill. It is ordered that Willis Bradshaw guardian of Elizabeth McNeill, John McNeill (and James McNeill pay to him the sum of \$42.00 for their bond for the year 1859.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County Summon all the acting Justices of this County newly commissioned to the next term of this Court to qualify themselves.

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John Crumpler who has been elected Constable in District No. 7 in this County for the term of two years commencing the first day of July 1860, together with Wm R. Stephenson and Saml B. Kille his securities (who have justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into (and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned according to law ^{and} thereupon took the several oaths prescribed by law which bond is ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term
