

Robert Barnes guardian of Juliet Alwell. Ex parte.

The Commissioner in this cause this day made his report.

Ordered that Coleman Hines be appointed Surveyor of the Brown road from Barkham's Mill to the Gray Squire post office thence to Bannell's meeting house in the room of Richard Brown deceased And it is ordered that the usual laws do work thereon.

On the motion of Emma Beale widow of Jethro Beale dec'd. who made oath and request with Andrew J. Mills & Miles Alwell her securities (who justified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand Dollars, duplicate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Jethro Beale dec'd in due form.

Ordered that James G. Alwell, Miles Alwell, Andrew J. Mills and Henry Ferguson or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Jethro Beale dec'd that may be produced to them (and make due return of the same.

Nicholas J. Barkham this day asked the consent of the Court to remove to the State of North Carolina the original bonds executed by Benjamin Barkham as the guardian to Emeline and Robert Davis with his securities Nicholas J. Barkham and Zebulon A. Simmons which application was refused by the Court because the law forbids the removal of any official papers from the office.

The last Will and Testament of Sarah Jones dec'd. was proved by the oaths of Calvin A. Scarborough & Miles Scarborough two of the subscribing witnesses thereto (and thereupon ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of John D. Swell who is bound in this bond as one of the securities of Allen B. Jones as guardian of Alnt. A. Pope, George B. Pope, Martha J. Pope, Frederick Pope, and Mary M. Pope, orphans of Anderson Pope dec'd. This day the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing that the Defendant has had legal notice of this motion and he not appearing it is ordered that the said Allen B. Jones shall give before this Court a new bond as Guardian aforesaid with sufficient security in the penalty of two thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law or have his powers revoked and annulled and that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant the costs of this motion.

The bond doth against Barkham A. Thomas, as guardian of Samuel Ellis, Richard Ellis, & Thomas Ellis, orphans of Samuel Ellis dec'd. Whereupon he together with John McChidehead & Alnt. A. Jones his securities, (who justified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law.
