It is ordered that an amount of the poor of this County do bind Lewis Freeman, aged two years, Susan Freeman, aged 3 years, Nathan Freeman aged four years, Elspeth Freeman aged six years, John Freeman aged 8 years &c. him. And it is ordered that the master pay for the services of the apprentice, Lewis Freeman, to the overseer of the poor of this County for the use of the said apprentice \$5.50 a year for the last ten years for which he is to be bound, for the services of Susan Freeman for her use \$3.00 a year for the last seven years for which she is to be bound, for the services of Nathan Freeman for his use \$5.00 a year for the last ten years for which he is to be bound, for the services of Elspeth Freeman for her use \$6.00 a year for the last ten years for which he is to be bound and for the services of John Freeman for his use \$10.00 a year for the last ten years for which he is to be bound, the said apprentices being free negroes to be bound according to law. For the payment of which sums bonds or bonds shall be taken by the overseer binding the said apprentices.
