On the motion of the defendant by his attorney who pleads

1859. Subject to a credit of \$179. - paid February 22nd 1860.
Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover
against the defendant four hundred and twenty eight dollars & fifty
cents with legal interest thereon from the 18th day of July 1859
till paid, and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf
expended. And the said defendant in money 5. But this
judgment is subject to a credit of \$179. - paid February
22nd 1860.
