Hears of Deceit as per Deceit filed.

The Court doth nominate and appoint Joshua Dettlar guardian of Mary E. Williams orphan of Seth D. Williams. dec'd. Whereupon he together with Jos. E. Gillette & J. D. Dettlar his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

William Jeyner having obtained an attachment against Jesse Johnson his tenant for the sum of twenty dollars payable the 25th day of December 1860, who intends to remove or is removing his effects from the leased tenement aforesaid before the time of the payment of the rent aforesaid to be levied upon the goods and chattels of the said Jesse Johnson returnable to the Court which has been levied upon sundry goods and chattels; This day came the said William Jeyner and the said Jesse Johnson was solemnly called, but came not. Whereupon the Court doth enter the officer who levied the said attachment to sell the goods attached for money to be paid at the time the rent for which the said attachment issued shall become due the purchaser giving good security for each payment; and the said officer is to assign the bonds taken for the same and the costs to the said William Jeyner; and the overplus, if any, of such sale, besides the charges of attachment and sale, he is to return to the said Jesse Johnson.

Upon satisfactory evidence appearing to the Court, it doth hereby certify that Henry T. Maget to whom County Land Warrant No 71. 552 was issued on the fifth day of October 1857 for one hundred and sixty acres under an act of Congress of March 3^d 1855, and who arrived & resided this life in the State of Arkansas County of Pinebluff on the sixth day of November in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight intestate and leaving as his only heir at law Eldridge Chastain Maget his son to whom the said warrant lawfully descends, who is now a citizen of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, and is of the lawful age of twenty one years.

Wm D. Bryant is appointed Surveyor of the road from Smith's Ferry to the North Carolina State line - and it is ordered that the usual bounds together with the bounds on Amos Copeland's land do work thereon.
