

To whom being Land Warrant No 21650 dated 2^d day of February 1856 for 80 acres of land issued, died on the first day of December 1858, and that John Charles and Sally Rames formerly Charles now under in the say heirs at law of the said Edick Charles and that they are now of one year of age.

The last Will and Testament of Joseph H. Johnson dec'd. was proved by the oaths Wm H. Corbett, John F. Corbett and Wiley Duck, the subscribing witnesses thereto and added to be recorded. And in the motion of Zachariah Johnson, one of the executors therein named who made oath and together with Josephus Turner & Samuel Corbett his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form Liberty is reserved to Samuel S. Johnson the other executor therein named to be joined in the said probate.

Ordered that Williams Atkinson, Samuel Corbett and John F. Corbett being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels and real estate of Joseph H. Johnson dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

Ordered that Still H. Dishob and Warren Edwards two of the Commissioners of this County, do to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Cypress Bay, and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

William Beak is appointed Surveyor of the road from the Sign post near Simon Murfis late residence to South quay ferry in the room of Willis W. Lawrence deceased. And it is ordered that the usual hands be paid thereon.

Ordered that Samuel Drury and Robert Newland, two of the Commissioners of roads of this County do to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge across Angelica Swamp and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
