

in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to Richard J. Darden the sum of two hundred and twenty eight Dollars and ninety three cents for painting Couthouse &c.

¶ Ordered that Wm W. Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Iffe Turner Dec'd. and administer the same according to Law.

¶ On the motion of James J. Darden, executor of Wm S. Biddle Dec'd and as such quasi guardian of Donja C. Biddle is allowed to pay out of the principal of his said ward's estate to Dr. C. D. Graham a medical bill of \$80.00 or as much thereof as he may think just and proper.

Ordered that an Overseer of the Poor of this County, do bind Nicholas Love, free negro, aged thirteen years, son of Rebecca Love to Wm A. Bell and it is ordered that the master or for the services of the apprentice in the art, trade or business he is to be taught pay to the master the sum of twenty Dollars a year except for the two last years, which is to be returned to be paid to the apprentice when he arrives to the age of twenty one years and the Overseer of the Poor by whom this order shall be executed shall take from the master bonds with security for the payment of the said amounts.

Ordered that James James & Demarius L. Dole two of the Commissioners of roads of this County let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Lower Seacock Bridge and receive the same when completed and make report to Court.

Ordered that the Clerk register Lewis Scott free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by his former register.

On the Application of Daniel W. Cobb, James C. Sobell Richard J. Darden, Jonathan Darden, Iffra Little, and Robert Whitehead to open a new road from Jerusalem to the Barn Tavern.

This day came the parties by their attorney and the Sheriff pursuant to a writ in the nature of a writ of ad quod damnum awarded at the last Court returned an inquisition in these words: (here inserted.) Whereupon on hearing as well the said parties by their attorney as the attorney for the Commonwealth and all circumstances being weighed, the Court is of opinion, and doth accordingly order that leave be given the applicants to open said road, provided they will build a new bridge on said road and open said road without charge upon the County and put the same in good and legal repair, and James D. Bryant and Henry M. Routh are appointed to receive the said road when the same shall be opened and put in good repair.
