

is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Eliza S. Gardner dec'd. in due form.

John A. Handley having gone before a Justice of the peace of this County, and made oath that William Handley, his tenant, is liable to pay him the said John A. Handley, fair rent of a certain messuage & tenement situate & being in said County, one half of the crops of the value of \$175.00 of all kinds grown on said tenement for the year 1860, which will be due and payable on the 1st of January 1861, of which he has received no part, & has moreover made oath before me that he truly believes that the said William Handley intends to remove or make way with his effects from the said tenement aforesaid & that unless an attachment issue then will not be left out the said premises property liable to distress sufficient to satisfy the said rent so to become payable and the said Justice having thereupon issued an attachment against the estate of the said William Handley returnable to this Court, which has been levied by James B. Vick one of the Constables of this County upon the following property of the said William Handley: "a Lot of corn & stacks of food &c". This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard and the Court doth ascertain the value in money of the rent for which the said attachment issued to be one hundred dollars with interest thereon from the first day of January 1861, and doth order the officer who served the said attachment to sell the property attached by him as aforesaid as the law directs, and out of the money arising from such sale pay and satisfy the rent ascertained as aforesaid to the said John A. Handley with interest thereon from the 1st day of January 1861 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended. And that the said officer make return according to law.

On the motion of Saml. Corbett and for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that an Overseer of the poor of this County, do bind Goodman Jaynes, negro, aged 25 years to Saml. Corbett and it is ordered that the said Master for the services of the apprentice, pay to the overseers of the poor of this County for the use of the said apprentice fifteen dollars a year during the term for which he is to be bound, for the payment of which sum bond shall be taken by the overseers binding the said apprentice.

To secure the attendance of fit Jurors on tomorrow, the Court doth order that the Sheriff summon twelve Jurors to attend the Court on that day.

It is ordered that the Court be adjourned till 11 morning Monday 10. October.
