

Pliff for the premises in the Declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant possession of the tenement aforesaid and his costs by him in this behalf expended. And a writ of Habere Facias possessionis is awarded to cause the plaintiff to have such possession.

On the motion of Person S. Thomas who made oath and together Amos S. Dole, his security, (who justified in oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted the said Person S. Thomas to obtain letters of administration with the estate of Martha Cloud late wife of Richard H. Cloud in due form.

The Court doth appoint George E. Dole Committee of May for a person of unsound mind. Whereupon he together John Barkham & Richard J. Dardun, his securities, (who justified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

Ordered that D. L. Dole & John Cobb two of the Commissioners of roads of this County let at the lowest price the repairs of Round Hill Bridge near Berlin and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

On the motion of Wm. W. Briggs late Sheriff of Administrator of Henry Joyner dec'd. & Benjamin D. Dole assignee of said Dole John Barkham is appointed trustee in a Decd. Dated 10th October 1842, from Henry Joyner to Augustus Dole for the benefit of Susan Dole and recorded in Southampton County Court October 17th 1842 the said Augustus Dole the trustee being dead.

On the motion of A. S. H. Burges. It is ordered that Willis Bradshaw auditor of John Griffin deceased who was guardian of John C. Griffin out of any moneys in his hands belonging to the said John C. Griffin pay to the said A. S. H. Burges the sum of \$176.25 & \$174.00.

Ordered that the Clerk register Harriet Love, free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by her former register.

Ordered that George W. Vick Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Lydia Joy dec'd. to be administered according to law.

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
