

On the application of Robert Pittow to open a new road from Little Swanee bridge on the Frederic road to Ivor Station. It is ordered that Wm. H. Summrell & James Jones Esq. of the Commissioners of roads of this County, view the ground proposed for opening said road and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as the public and especially whether any yard, garden, orchard or any part thereof, will in such case have to be taken.

It is ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in his hands most otherwise appropriated pay to James R. Lytle the sum of fifteen Dollars.

On the motion of Robert Buford who made solemn affirmation as the law directs, and together Joel Cook his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond with penalty of four thousand Dollars conditioned according to law, but his estate is granted him for obtaining return of Administration on the estate of William Buford decd. in due form.

The Court doth appoint Livingston Gardner guardian of his children Sarah A. Gardner, Anna S. Gardner and William J. Gardner. Whereupon he together with James Hurdley and John Hurdley, his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered in to and acknowledged a bond with penalty of one thousand Dollars conditioned according to law.

It is ordered that John Drictor, Theophilus Morris, Ransom G. Hamell and W. H. Pittow or any three of them being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods and chattels of William Buford decd. that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

For persons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that an overseer of the poor of this County do bind William Diggs, freemason, aged seven years son of Sarah Diggs to William L. Wrenn. The master paying for the services of the apprentice each year to the mother the sum of \$1.50 except for the last year when he is to pay to the apprentice \$7.00 when he arrives to the age of twenty one year for the payment of which sum bond shall be taken by the overseer who shall execute this order.
