

On the motion of George H. Gardner. It is ordered that W^m Atkinson, M. D. M. Clayton and Leonard L. Cobb who are appointed for the purpose allot to Emily Joyner widow of Jeremiah Joyner Decd. as dower one third in value of the land of which her husband the said Jeremiah Joyner died seized and possessed and make report to Court.

The Court being satisfied that James Standley was lawfully charged with the tax for the year 1860, on three negroes amounting to \$3.60 and that he has paid the same; on the application of James Standley order that the said amount of tax be paid by the said James Standley be refunded to him. The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present in Court defending the application.

* Ordered that Samuel Drury and Robert Howland two of the Commissioners of roads of this County let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding of the bridge over Westbrook's Mill swamp and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

* Ordered that Warren Edwards, Nathl N. Bishop and James D. Bryant three of the Commissioners of roads of this County be directed to receive sealed proposals for letting out the repairs of the embankment of the bridge & abutments near Jerusalem & return them to the next Court.

* Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
