Whitehead Fifty eight Dollars in bank bills as at this day set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and the Court having heard the evidence are of opinion that ~~felony~~ has been committed and that there is probable cause to charge the accused therewith, doth remand him for trial in the Circuit Court of this County, at the next term; And on the motion of the said Robert Bachman he is allowed to give bail for his personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Court of Southampton County on the first day the next term then of to stand his trial for the felony aforesaid with which he stands charged, himself to be bound in a recognizance in the sum of fifty ^{dollars} with good security in the like sum of fifty dollars. And thereupon the said Robt. Bachman is remanded to jail.
