

The Board of the Overseers of the Poor of this County, this day made their annual report.

The Commissioners of roads directed to let to the lowest undertaker the Bridge across the Angelica Swamp, the Bridge across Westbrook's Mill Swamp, & the keeping of the raft from Haley's bridge across Mcherrin River, this day made their report.

James H. Bell one of the Commissioners of the Revenue, ^{in this county} being unable to perform the duties of his office, he is permitted to employ Franklin Vick to assist him - And thereupon the said Franklin Vick took the several oaths prescribed by law.

The last Will and testament of Cass Brown dec'd. was proved by the oaths of Wm. Babb and Nathan Turner Jr. two of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and the Codicil thereto annexed was partly proved by the oath of Nathan Turner Jr. one of the subscribing witnesses thereto (and the same is continued for further proof).

William Knapp having obtained an attachment against the estate of John Hollas for \$16.75, which has been levied by C. F. Brown one of the Constables in this County on 175 dozen eggs. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney, who being fully heard it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the sum of three dollars with interest thereon from the 13th day of March, 1864, till paid & his costs in this behalf expended. And it is ordered that the officer who served this attachment make sale of the property so attached by him and out of the money arising from such sale pay and satisfy the said sum of three dollars with the interest afore said and the costs in this behalf expended. And that the said officer make due return of the same.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon all the acting Justices to be next term to take into consideration and carry into effect the provisions of the act of the General Assembly entitled "an act to authorize the County Comptrol and any incorporated City or town to arm the Militia of their respective Counties Cities and towns, and to provide means therefor" passed January nineteenth 1861.

Ordered that Geo. W. Vick Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of William J. Porter dec'd to be administered according to law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
