Peale, the Subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be record And on the motion of Thomas Hall and Timothy Langston the executors therein named who made oath and together with Henry Chapman, Nathan Atkinson, John R. Hill and Jackson Holland their scavvilles, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Fifty thousand dollars conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on this said Will in due form.

Ordered that Wm. H. Riggs, W. A. Mansbury and
Edwards, being sworn for the purpose do appraise all
goods & chattels and real estate of Garrison James dec'd
may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

On the motion of Nath'l. H. Bishop who made oath and together with
Wm. H. Riggs and John Farndale, his scavvilles, (who justified on
oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in
the penalty of One thousand Dollars conditioned according to law,
Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration
on the estate of John W. H. Bishop dec'd in due form.

Ordered that David Daniels, S. L. Story, Miles Sly, and John V. Sly
or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise
all the goods & chattels of John W. H. Bishop dec'd that may
be produced to them and make due return of the same.

Ordered that the Clerk register Malvina Weston, Isabella Weston
Robert Henry Weston, and Edmund Weston, five negroes, who were
born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Edwin
Wells and Matthew Roberts, freemen, who was born free
in this County as appears by the testimony of Wm. H. Weston

Ordered that George W. Vick Sheriff of this County take into
his hands the estate of Simon Jose D. to be administered according
