On the motion of Seth W. Bishop who made oath and together with Wm. W. Briggs and John Jakubiec, his securities, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged and labored in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John W. E. Bishop dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that David Ramer, J. E. Story, Miles Story, and Abner Dickson, being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of John W. E. Bishop dec'd. that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

Ordered that the Clerk register Malvina S. Butler, Isabella S. Butler, Robert Henry Butler, and Emma S. Butler, four negroes, who were born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Edwin Williams and Martha Roberts, free negroes, who were born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Wm.
