

At Quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton County,  
held at the Courthouse thereof on Monday, the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1861.  
Present, Samuel R. Helle, presiding Justice, Elisha J. Parker,  
John E. Bugge, Justices.

The Clerk this day returned a list of all writings admitted to record in this  
Court during and since the last preceding term under Chapter 131 of the  
Code of Virginia, which list having been read to the Court is  
ordered to be incorporated with the minutes of the proceedings of the day and  
is as follows, Court:

Ded of Bargain and Sale dated 21<sup>st</sup> January 1861, from Wm. C. Cobb  
Committee to Sam'l R. Helle, Conveying land, was admitted  
to record, July 1<sup>st</sup> 1861.

Ded of Bargain and Sale dated 26<sup>th</sup> March 1861, from Mrs. W. Hines  
wife to James T. Blombe, Conveying land, was admitted  
August 9<sup>th</sup> 1861.

On the motion of James Will it is ordered that E. W. Maford be  
appointed Trustee in the place of Wm. S. Edwards his? to carry  
into execution all acts of trust executed by Thomas Henson to the  
said Edwards for the benefit of James Will on the day  
1<sup>st</sup> of February 1844, now of record in the office of this Court.

On the motion of Wm. Atkinson who made such and to whom will  
Thomas Hall & George W. Vick, his successors, (who justified on  
us to this Delegation) turned into (and acknowledged above) the  
property of four thousand Dollars, conditioned according to law, ex-  
cepting being granted him for obtaining letters of administration on  
the estate of Robert Reid d. & in due form.

Ordered that John Ross, Sam'l. Rabbits, L. A. Lester, Jack Johnson  
& John M. Leabird or any three of them, bring suit to the pres-  
ent, to appraise all the goods & chattels of Robert Reid d.  
that may be produced to them and make an return of the  
same.

The last will and testament of Sarah M. A. Somers d.  
was this day proved by the oaths of Sam'l. Drayton, Robert W.  
Lyon, two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and before solemnized  
said Joseph W. Glass the executor therein named having refused  
to take upon himself the burden of the execution of said  
will, did no person appearing for administration with the will  
engaged on the said date in Thompson. Ordered that George W. Vick  
Sheriff of this County take into his hands the said will  
to be administered according to law.
