

A Writing bearing date 13th day of June 1857 purporting to be the last will & Testament of Robert Hunt dec^d was produced to the Court and continued till the next Court to be put aside.

George M. Rodgers who stands bound by recognizance entered into before this Court on the 16th day of September 1857 with School H. Humphreys his security to appear here this day to answer the Commencement of a writ of Habeas Corpus which has been issued, was solemnly called but came not. Whereupon it is ordered that a writ of Habeas Corpus be issued against the said George M. Rodgers and his said security returnable here to the first day of November Term next.

Ordered that the Clerk Register Sarah Frances Boon who was born free in this County as appears by the evidence of Parker & Gory

The Court appoint James G. Jones & Alfred E. Stephenson Curators of the Estate of Robert Hunt dec^d during the absence of his wife and through the said James G. Jones & Alfred E. Stephenson made sale and together with Wilbur Stephenson, Thomas J. Bristol & Lemuel S. Piles their associates (who justified in such as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

Ordered that Wilbur Stephenson, Thos. J. Bristol, Jas. M. Jones & R. M. Piles or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose aforesaid sell the goods or chattels of Robert Hunt dec^d which may be produced or shown to them and return the aforesaid, signed by themselves to the Clerk of this Court.

On the motion of John Pope who made oath and together with Anne E. Pope his security who justified in such as to their sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John E. Pope dec^d in due form.

Ordered that the Estate of Lucy Bond dec^d be committed to the hands of George W. Vicks Sheriff of this County to be administered according to law.

Ordered that the estate of Nathaniel Whitfield (free negro) dec^d be committed to the hands of George W. Vicks Sheriff of this County to be administered according to law.

Ordered that Silas H. Bishop Adm^r of Gray has of the Commissioners of Roads let to the Court under the approval of Hards Bridge or Caffrey's Swamp receive the same when settled and make report to Court.

Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor of this County sell on the premises to the high bidder on public auction the tract the Globe Land known as Orange Church, and on receiving bond with good security for the payment of the purchase money payable to the said Overseers of the Poor that they convey the property sold to the purchaser thereof.

On the motion of Horod Pope who made oath and together with R. M. Piles his security (who justified in such as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Horod Pope dec^d in due form.

On the motion of William B. Gray who made oath and together with C. C. Vaughan his security (who justified in such as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars
