Ann Weaver a free negro who stands charged with a felony by her complaint in the County of Southampton and within the jurisdiction of this Court in that she the said Ann Weaver did unlawfully and maliciously burn the kitchen, an out house and the premises of and the property of Charles Hollands, and the contents of the sum of the value of four hundred dollars was the say the Court having heard the evidence and the prisoner in her defence by Counsel were unanimously of opinion that the said Ann Weaver is guilty of the offence whereunto she stands charged and it being demanded of her if any thing for herself she had whereunto say why the Court should not now proceed to pronounce judgment against her and nothing being offered or alleged in defence or against it as usual by the Court that the said Ann Weaver be committed to the imprisonment of this Court until the term of three years, therein to be kept and treated as the law directs. And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County shall as soon as may be remove after the adjournment of this Court, remove and safely convey the said Ann Weaver from the jail of this County to the said Penitentiary and there detain her in the confinement thereof, and that the said Ann Weaver is remanded to jail.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County remove all the felony Justice thereof to January Court and to consider such delinquents as may be brought before them connected with the existing term.

Side

Ordered that the account of John Richardson Justice amounting to \$38.²² by the account of J. B. Lewis Clerk of this Court amounting to \$11.14 be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his annual and final payment.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
