This cause came on this day to be again heard on the papers formerly read, on the report of the Comptrol made at the last term to which no exception is filed and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court did advise, order and decree that the report aforesaid be held firm & stable and binding between the parties and that the costs of this suit be proportionally borne between the parties -

On motion James M. Ball Comptrol of the Revenue for Neway Parish in this County James S. Holmes be permitted to qualify as his assistant Comptrol, whereupon the said Holmes qualified by taking the oath prescribed by law.

Ordered that the Clerk Register Neway Parish <sup>and</sup> for anyone who was born free in this County or appears from the testimony of R. J. Boyard

On motion of Thomas J. Bonner guardian of Sarah J. Bonner Ordered that he be allowed to represent twenty dollars of the principal of his Ward's Estate for his schooling &c.

Orris Brown alias Bluffell a free negro who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the Jurisdiction of the Court in this that he did in the night of the 30<sup>th</sup> December 1861 feloniously and unlawfully burn the prison and Jail of this County on this day but to the last in Court of the Sheriff of this County and the Court heard and the evidence are of opinion that the said Orris Brown alias Bluffell ought to be detained for the offence of which he stands charged before the next Court of this County. And thereupon the said Orris Brown alias Bluffell is committed to Jail.

On motion of James M. Maguire tutor of Thomas Brown &c. and a book given guardian of Catherine and Lewis M. Brown R. Ruggie R. J. H. W. Flowers F. & Pauline G. W. Brown, he is allowed to represent of the principal of the said Lewis M. Brown A. the sum of \$155 of the said Ruggie R. J. H. W. Flowers F. & Pauline G. W. Brown \$60. each for each of the years 1860 & 1861 for the support of said Lewis with interest at each of the said amounts from the end of each year.
