Orris Brown alias Chappell a free negro who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the Jurisdiction of the Court in this that he stole on the night of the 30th of October 1861 feloniously and unlawfully bore the prison and jail of this County on the day set to the law in Court of the Sheriff of this County and the Court having heard the evidence and of opinion that the said Orris Brown alias Chappell ought to be detained for the offence of which he stands charged before the Grand Court of this County - And thereupon the said Orris Brown alias Chappell is committed to Jail

On motion of James M. Haughey executor of Thomas Leonard's estate and a bill given guardian of Caroline and Lewis M. Ruggles R. Joel H. Winfield W. Florence F. & Pauline G. Leonard, he is allowed to report of the principal of the said Leonard's estate the sum of \$155 of the said Anne M. \$125 of the said Ruggles R. Joel H. Winfield W. Florence F. & Pauline G. Leonard \$60. each for each of the years 1860 & 1861 for the support of said Leonard's wife with interest at each of the said amounts from the first of each year
