In Chancery

Present, Robert M. Dole, At W. Vaughan, Justices.

For reasons appearing to the Court, Ordered that your Plaintiff be authorized to draw at the Sheriff of this County for the sum of three thousand dollars and that the Sheriff answer the said bill of any money in his hands levied for owing, requiring the Sheriff to purchase provision for the Poor of this County.

This day, John Bryant, who alleges that he is commonly aggrieved by an entry on the books of personal property made by James A. Bell Commissioner of the Revenue for William Powell in the County for the year 1860 whereby he was charged with one dollar and eighty cents taxes for the year 1861, on personal property, namely 2 ewes white and sheep and six duck. John Bryant, went into Court to complain but found no account of one dollar and eighty cents part of the taxes so commonly charged against him for the said year, which account was disputed by James A. Bell the Attorney for the Commissioner for said County. And the Commissioner not being present to be examined the Court refused to sustain the application.

On the motion of George A. Lomax who came with me together with Isaac G. Taylor his attorney who justified me with a note to his sufficiency, moved and was ordered to pay me the sum of twelve hundred dollars, conditions according to law. Cost of defense is granted him for attorney, keeper of administration and the state of attorney Christopher Lee in due form.
