

At a Monthly Term of the County Court of Southampton County held at the Courthouse there of on  
Meeting the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1862.  
Present Samuel D. Hales, Presiding Justice, James M. Lewis,  
Chancery Law Justices.

The Clerk this day returned a copy of all writings admitted to Record in this Court during or since the  
last preceding Term under the 1<sup>st</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> of the Code of Virginia, which last hearing time is fixed by the Court  
is intended to be inserted among the minutes of the proceedings of the day and is as follows to wit—  
Deed from James P. Hart to William W. Branch, Surveyor bonds was admitted

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the active Justices of this County to be present  
and meet to day and affix the County Seal & for what purpose—

This cause came on this day to be heard on the papers formerly read, and on the report of the Commissioner  
made at the last term to which respect no exception has been filed and was agreed by counsel. On consideration whereof  
decreed to confirm the said report.

The Commissioner appointed to let to the lowest bidder the repairs of land near the bridge at  
Franklin the day next instant.

The last Will and Testament of General Disney is now presented to the Court.  
A Writing bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of December 1861 specifying the last Will and Testament of  
General Disney deceased, was produced in Court and the Subscribing witnesses thereunto being  
about in number of the Confederates Army. Name of one of said W. H. Disney being sworn, lawfully signed  
and sealed by me will be incorporated with the above writing of the said General Disney and accordingly the  
said Will admitted as well as the signature thereof to be in the proper hand writing of the said General Disney  
Whereupon it is ordered that the said Willing be recorded as and for the last Will and Testament as heretofore  
of the said General Disney deceased. And on the motion of Williamson I grant you one of the Executrix thereon  
name who made will seal together with Benjamin W. Ferguson, Francis T. Riley, Thomas Riley his  
Daughter (who justified me with as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged same and for a sum of  
two hundred and fifty thousand dollars conditioned according to law, certificate of payment here for money  
paid to the said Williamson for liberty being received to the other executors therein named to be given in  
the last probate when they may think fit.

Ordered that James Disney, W. H. Disney, James E. Pates & Robert Rowland & any three of them being  
only executors for the purpose to appear all be paid or charged of General Disney deceased together with the  
cost of which may be subject to the authority of the Executor and return the instrument signed by the  
to the Clerk of this Court.
