In consequence of the destruction ^{by fire} ~~of~~ ⁱⁿ of this Court it is ordered that the Clerk of this Court cause or cause to be removed all the records of his Office or such of them as he in his discretion ^{shall} ~~deem~~ place in or out of this State so he may have ready to be returned when the same has ceased - And for the purpose of defraying the expense of said removal to the said Clerk is authorized to draw upon the Sheriff of this County for the sum of five hundred dollars to be paid out of any money in his hands due the County -

* The Commissioners appointed to let the rebuilding of bridge over Applewhite Mill to repair the segment thereof.

An account of Benjamin G. Pope Trustee of the finance Committee of this County was this returned, affixed by the Court & ordered to be filed.

Dennis L. Dole is appointed surveyor of the road from the Merig branch to Round hill bridge in the town of Wilson Station named, and it is ordered that the usual bond be made thereon.
