Ordered that George W. Vick Sheriff of this County take into his hands the Estate of William W. Crockett and administer the same according to law.

Ordered that George Fogg, Abner L. Gray, Richard M. Carr & John Pope or any 3 of them being sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods or chattels of William W. Crockett and send return of appraisal signed by them to the Clerk of the Court.

It appearing to the Court that the records of this Court are undeposited
 In consequence of the destruction and loss of this Court ^{the money} it is ordered that the Clerk of the Court remove or cause to be removed all the records of his Office or such of them as he in his discretion ^{may deem} proper to some safe place in or out of this State as he may deem best. To be returned when the danger has ceased. And for that purpose of defraying the expenses of said removal to the said Clerk is authorized to draw upon the Sheriff of this County for the sum of fifty hundred dollars to be paid out of any moneys in his hands due the County.

Joseph W. Cloud, Orman M. Noyes, Davis Barrett, W. C. Myrick, Edwin Harris, Matthew W. Thompson, Samuel M. Haines, Lemuel S. Dole, W. W. Cobb are added to the Committee heretofore appointed to attend to the families of absent Volunteers & Militiamen now in the Confederate service, and for so doing for the same and ordered that they be summoned to the next Court.

The Commissioners appointed to let the rebuilding of bridge across Appleton's Mill to make the report.

An account of Benjamin C. Pope Treasurer of the finance Committee of this County was also returned, approved by the Court & ordered to be filed.

Drummond S. Dole is appointed surveyor of the road from the Mowing branch to Round hill bridge in the town of Wilson's Hill and it is ordered that the usual bond be watered.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
